Memorial Day Weekend – White River Wildlife Area
May 28-30, 2016

You are cordially invited to join Traditional Archers of Oregon for three days of archery fun on the high desert at White River Wildlife Area near Tygh Valley along the historic Oregon Trail. On-site primitive camping with room for RVs and trailers (no hook-ups) will be available starting on Thursday.

Three championship, 15-target 3-D courses, plus kids trail shoot (under adult supervision please) will be set up, as well as a practice area.

Novelties will include a competitive money shoot, the Clanging Balls O’Death and flying goose.

Archers can only shoot recurves, longbows and selfbows. Bring your favorite arrows (wood, metal, carbon) including flu-flu’s, but NO broadheads or blunts please! Also, NO sights, releases, binoculars or range finders on the courses.

Pre-register and receive a special raffle ticket and event memento; T-Shirts available by pre-order.

Pets - you are expected to control and clean up after them.

Registration will open on Friday afternoon.

All vehicle travel restricted to roadways and campgrounds. **ATV's are prohibited** in the White River Wildlife Area.

Dust can be an issue on the roads so please be considerate of those camped near them when driving.

No firearm use allowed on site.

Dogs **must** be under control at all times. Clean up after your pet.

No UNREGISTERED "SHOOTERS" or ALCOHOL permitted on courses.

Adults must supervise all shooters under the age of twelve and accompany children on the "KIDS COURSE".

Shoot as often as you like except, one course designated by T.A.O., will be closed on Sunday morning for the Money Shoot. **PLEASE ABIDE BY THIS CLOSURE FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR COURSE WORKERS.**

Recurves, longbows and selfbows only. NO compound bows, mechanical releases, sights, etc...

You may use your arrow of choice. However, field points only. NO BROADHEADS or BLUNTS please.

Raffles, awards and passing of the banner will be held Sunday evening. All courses will be open until 11a.m. on Monday.
