Archery Shoot schedule of events

10:00 am - 7:00 pm Range open – shoot with friends – no organized competition
11:00 am – Noon Novelty shoot # 1 - To be announced
1:00 pm – 3:00 pm Blanket shoot – “competitive” shoot for donated prizes
4:00 pm – 5:00 pm Novelty shoot #2 – To be announced
Dark – Dark Thirty Novelty shoot #3 – Flashlight shoot

Entry Fees/Prizes/Rules:

Open Range:

Entry: No charge.
Prizes: Non-competitive. Shoot as much as you want with old/new friends. Side bets allowed
Rules: #1 HAVE FUN!
#2 Any archery equipment allowed during open shooting. There will be some ‘loaner’ traditional equipment available for anyone interested.
#3 NO BROADHEADS. By request of our gracious hosts, the Pocatello Field Archers.

Novelty shoots:

Entry: \$2.00 per event – 100% pay-out
Prizes: 1st place = 80%, 2nd place = 20%
Rules: #1 HAVE FUN!
#2 Traditional equipment only (to level the playing field). There will be some ‘loaner’ equipment available.

NOTE: Novelty shoots will be individual or team events. They are designed for fun more than for competition. We are keeping the nature of the events secret until the gathering. Look forward to this, you may get to do something that you have never done or find a throw-back to the distant past.

Blanket shoot:

Entry: Bring a prize to place on the blanket to participate
Awards: 1st place gets 1st choice from the blanket, 2nd place gets 2nd choice, and so on until the last place finisher gets last pick.
Rules: #1 HAVE FUN!
#2 Traditional equipment only (to level the playing field). There will be some ‘loaner’ equipment available.
#3 This is a scored range shoot but will not be structured like most 3D shoots. Details will be provided at the event. Join in and have some fun.

NOTE: You get to decide what you place on the blanket. It can range from something of great value to a ‘gag’ prize. I have seen items on blankets ranging from custom bows to an old boot. The only requirement is that you provide an item so everyone wins something. It will be fun!

Signage

We'll sign the interstate from Exit 63 all the way up to the archery range. Look for the BHA/ITB logo and follow the bear tracks (BHA logo)!

Please bring a main dish for Saturday night to share, wild game would be great if you were so lucky. If not, well, bring something to cook over the fire, grill or Dutch oven. BHA will provide side dishes, cold pop and beer. Regarding the latter, we've arranged for a keg or two of local beer from Portneuf Valley Brewing.

Lunch is on your own, of course, both the fire ring and grill will be available if you choose to use them.

Camping

Primitive camping is available on site at the Scout Mountain Archery Range. We'll set up an area in the meadow for tents and have another area for camp trailers. There is an outhouse; no running water other than the creek. We have picnic tables, a fire ring and barbeque grills will be available.
