In 2019, a new 3-D archery range was installed on the Boise River Wildlife Management Area. This 20-target, walk-through range has stations dispersed throughout a mile-long course. Archers can shoot at varying distances at three-dimensional foam targets that imitate many of the animals they might hunt in Idaho.
