

Idaho Traditional Bowhunters Monthly Meeting Agenda June 8, 2023 6:30pm MST Zoom

1. Call to Order Zoom 6:30 pm MST by President Janet Houlihan

3. Treasurer's Report: Lisa Hall; Income and expenses since last meeting.

7. New Meadows Traditional Rendezvous, (June 23-25, 2023)
Preparations for site: On Tuesday, May 23 a visit to the site was made by Janet and Bill Houlihan, Dave and Lisa Hall, Ed and Bonnie Heasley, and Mark Wood to assess the cleanup area for a more radical brush removal to open more camping spots, and to evaluate the entry road and assess surface prep and possible gravel deposit. Gate installation was completed. Ed Heasley will return with grader to smooth road. John Warford is researching gravel costs for road.

NMTR Cleanup of Site: Date for cleanup is Saturday, June 17th at 9am. Please bring weed-trimmers, loppers, gloves, sunhat, and miscellaneous site cleanup equipment to ready the area for the shoot on the following weekend. Pat Lopez and Ed Heasley will bring mowers. Pasture will be mowed and campsites brushed out. Trails will be flagged and brush trimmed. We need to decide amount of payment for fuel and use of mower equipment for Pat and Ed? Do we need to provide lunch and if so what? Lisa and Dave are bringing target trailer to the shoot site on Saturday, June 17, 2023 and will leave it there for the shoot the following weekend.

- NMTR Schedule of Events: June 21 - June 25
- Wednesday June 21, Early bird campers/work crew may begin set up.
- Thursday, June 22, Work crew arrive 10 am and set up camps and unload target trailer. Begin moving targets to target sites along trails. Mark Wood will not be able to be with us, but we can still use his trailer to haul targets. We will need a proper vehicle to haul trailer loaded with targets through the narrow trails. Porta-potties/handwashing station to be delivered, 2 potties ordered.
- Friday, June 23, complete camp and target set up. Bowhunter Challenge stakes to be set by Don and Kevin Schroeder Thursday evening and Friday morning. Afternoon group course shoot and evaluation for safety. Registration and course opens 4 pm-Dusk. Volunteers needed to help with 10 pm flashlight shoot, 10 targets, groups of 4 - 5 shooters.
- Saturday, June 24 Registration open 8 am-1pm, Distribute (new) Member gift bags at registration. Raffle tickets will be sold and raffle table set up, will include Woodland Caribou target for raffle. Blanket Shoot cards may be picked up on Saturday and may be shot Saturday

or Sunday, cost for blanket shoot card is item for blanket. Bowhunter Challenge score cards, designed and printed by Don and Kevin Schroeder, available at registration, cost for card \$2 /course. Youth competition shoot, one course, may be done Saturday or Sunday. Saturday afternoon (2 pm?) Potato shoot (we need volunteers to set up shoot and run it); Speed competition (also need volunteers to help set it up and run it). Long Distance shoot and Bowbirds (adult supervision) after Potato and Speed (volunteers needed to set up and run).

- Sunday, June 25 Registration opens 8 am-noon. Blanket shoot cards and kids competition must be turned no later than noon. One pm Awards Ceremony: kids competition, Great Potato, Bowhunter Challenge, Flashlight, Speed, Long distance, Blanket. Raffle prizes announced and shoot ends. Course closes 2 pm, do target pickup (Volunteers needed!!!), clean trails and campground area. Porta-potties out on Monday. Overnight camping on Sunday if needed.

We need designated volunteers to take care of the various aspects of the event, so please be thinking about your particular skills and how you can help make this a special event. We'll begin the planning in August. Member discussion and vote on possibility of securing sponsors for ITB shoots in the future (request from Selkirk North).
