

IDAHO TRADITIONAL BOWHUNTERS JUNE MEETING

It was decided that in addition to your registration fee, it will cost \$5.00 for the challenge course. The other novelty shoots will cost you \$1.00 apiece. Bring your dollar bills. There will be trophies given for the Potato shoot and Bowhunters Challenge. And a 50/50 split for the other ones.

In preparation for the shoot there will be a clean up day on June 17th. The road will be smoothed out branches trimmed, paths mowed, and flagging done if enough time. Bring your weed whackers, trimmers and such to help. Pat Lopez and Ed Heasley will bring mowers. Dave and Lisa Hall will be bringing the target trailer up at that time. It was decided to pay Pat and Ed each \$100.00 for the use of their mowers. The club will be providing lunch.

Setting up for the shoot will begin on Thursday and finish up Friday morning. Registration will be on Friday afternoon from 4:00 to 6:00P.M. And then again Saturday morning and Sunday morning. We will need volunteers to help set up the course and take down Sunday after the shoot. The awards and blanket shoot prizes will be done on Sunday afternoon. Dave Hall will be bringing his Side by Side and little trailer to haul targets. Mark Wood will not be able to attend.

Janet was also approached about having sponsors for our club. Is this a good thing? She will be getting more particulars on this. And sharing it with the club. The North Idaho club has sponsors.

Western States will be held in Idaho next year. We will need lots of volunteers for this shoot. Janet is looking at a different site to host this event. Lots of things need to be worked out on this. Next meeting will be August 10th at 6:30 P.M.
