8. Western States Trad Rendezvous planning

An agreement has been reached to engage the two active clubs in the northern region of Idaho, (Selkirk Bowhunters/Tim Bertling and North Idaho Bowhunters/John Zieske) to combine with our club, the Idaho Traditional Bowhunters, the “umbrella club”, to put on this event. Thanks to all of you who gave your input in this decision making process, both pro and con, and hopefully we can all join together to make this upcoming gathering spectacular. Division of labor for all the various aspects of the shoot will be worked out by the leadership of the three clubs. Ideas and suggestions are welcome and will be considered. A spirit of cooperation, flexibility, and positive attitudes are critical in getting this well organized and running smoothly.

For Starters:

The pre-registration, on-site registration and advertising, vendors, sponsors, Logo design, will be handled by primarily by ITB (Janet, Lisa, and Shawn)

The pre-site prep and food prep and serving meal will be handled by SB (Tim)

The porta potties, vendors, sponsors, T-shirts and special “acts” will be handled by NIB (John)

Target set up will be a group effort of all three clubs.

Each club will contribute 15 targets and set up one course, so there will be 3 courses of 15 targets. Other targets may be available for practice and tuning and testing bows, they will be provided by the local clubs. Don Schroeder will be setting up Bowhunter Challenge stakes on at least one, maybe 2 courses.

A raffle will be held on Monday with proceeds going into the combined pot of the 3 clubs. It will be a combined effort to get raffle prizes.

Novelty shoots? Ideas and execution?

Compensation for each club will be an equal three way division of profits after all expenses are paid. Lisa Hall, our Secretary-Treasurer will handle all monies and the finances, with a cross-check assistance by Kathy Warford and Janet Houlihan.

The ITB folks coming from south Idaho will need a small (6-8' X 10 -12") enclosed trailer to transport the 15 targets to northern Idaho. Janet and Bill can haul with our motorhome, but need to borrow a trailer. We will select targets at the Fallen Archers Shoot.

I look forward to our club working with the northern clubs and have confidence this will be a great experience for all of us!
